NOTICE OF POSTPONEMENT

Notice is hereby given to the electors of the Whitefish Lake First Nation No. 128 that:

A Nomination meeting to be held on **Thursday, February 25th, 2021** at the Whitefish Lake Community Hall has been *postponed*.

An **Emergency Meeting was held on February 23, 2021** with the Whitefish Lake First Nation EMT and Indigenous Service Canada (ISC) due to the continuing increase of Covid-19. It was decided the Electoral Officer will meet with Dr. Wadieh Yacoub and Dr. Chris Sarin to provide a written letter addressed to the Nation Members in regard to their expert medical opinion to this upmost serious health matter.

The new date for Nominations has been scheduled for **April 1st**, **2021** from **6:00 p.m. ending at 8:00 p.m.** for the purpose of nominating candidates for the position of four **(4) Councillors**. The nomination meeting will be held according to the Customary Election Regulations of the Whitefish Lake First Nation No. 128.

And further take Notice that:

Should there be more eligible candidates than the number of positions for four (4) Councillors, the Election will be held on **Thursday, April 15th**, **2021** commencing at **8:00 a.m.** and ending at **8:00 p.m.** With two polling stations, the Election will be held at the **Community Hall** and **Pakan School** at the **Whitefish Lake First Nation No. 128**.

And further take Notice that:

The election for **Chief** shall come from among the elected Councillors on **Thursday, April 22**nd, **2021.**
