



The number one utmost important role of a Security Guard is to **OBSERVE** and **REPORT**.

We post throughout different locations within the Nation. These posts are identified by the Emergency Management Team's joint effort in working through COVID-19 Pandemic. Currently, there are 32 guards who complete reports based on observations witnessed throughout the duration of their 8-hour daily shift. We operate 24 hours a day and 7 days a week.

In the event that there is an emergency, incident, and or unusual occurrence, we follow up by contacting RCMP, Ambulance, Towing Company, or other identified first responders.

Guards are required to complete an incident report with every incident that has happened. These reports are then sent to RCMP for criminal matters or to appropriate Nation's designate.

This does not limit our job within the Nation solely to observing. Other important roles of a Security Guard include **detering and detecting crime, protection of people, protection of property, finding safety hazards, patrolling, traffic and crowd control.**

Security is responsible for keeping good public relations. It requires for guards to be in contact with the public and community members.

We are a recognized body that people can turn to should they have a problem that need to be dealt with in a professional manner.

In an emergency situation people look to Security to provide leadership. We are also expected to act quickly in such instances as sometimes this the means to saving peoples lives. It is our job to act accordingly as we are viewed as trusted people.

Additionally, Security is used to control access in different situations. Currently, we are working in the midst of a pandemic and are providing this service at Band Buildings with a goal of having the public and community members practice safety measures in regards to Covid-19. Our reporting is also utilized for contact tracing.

Security is used for alarm systems and monitoring. This also is a measure for access control.

As you may see, a Security Guard may hold the lives of many people in their hand, our main obligation and goal is **SAFETY**. Ultimately Security is for the Protection of People.
